BRIDGES OF COLORADO COMMISSION

POLICY ON COMMISSION MEETING ATTENDANCE

ARTICLE I: AUTHORITY

The Bridges of Colorado Commission ("Commission") recognizes that Commissioner attendance at established quarterly meeting is crucial to further the mission of the Office and accomplish the work and decision-making responsibilities of the Commission. To that end, the Commission originally adopted a Policy on Commission Meeting Attendance at its publicly noticed meeting held September 13, 2024. This is a written promulgation of that policy.

ARTICLE II: COMMISSION MEETING ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

Attendance – either in-person or virtual – at all regular Commission meetings is mandatory, unless previously excused by the Chair or Vice-Chair. If a Commission member has more than one excused or unexcused absence in a calendar year, the Chair, in his or her discretion and as may be delegated to the Director, may report such circumstances to the Commission member's appointing authority and request the appointment of the Commissioner be reconsidered.

At each meeting, minutes will be taken by the Office of Bridges of Colorado that will include a record of attendance.

The quarterly meeting schedule will be established by the Commission on an annual basis, distributed via email to all Commissioners, and published on the Bridges of Colorado website at bridges.colorado.gov.

Attendance at Commission workgroups and special meetings is not included in this policy.

ARTICLE III: AMENDMENTS

Procedures. This policy may be amended or repealed, in whole or in part, by a majority vote at any publicly noticed meeting of the Commission and shall be effective upon adoption or amendment.

Distribution. The latest version of this policy shall be made available to the public via the Bridges of Colorado website.
